

He advised the comrades that we are celebrating the Platinum Jubilee of All India State Bank of India Staff Federation and passing through the Platinum Jubilee year of the Federation.

Com.S.C. Balaji, President, National Confederation of Bank Employees while delivering the keynote address advised the comrades about the salient features of XIth Bipartite Settlement and narrated about the special achievements such as PLI, achievement of Medical Leave, Encashment of Privilege Leave every year for 5/7 days, sanction of additional 9th stagnation increment and lowering the periodicity of the stagnation increments from 3 to 2 years etc.

Com.Deepak Kumar Sharma, President, All India State Bank Officers' Federation, the distinguished guest conveyed his best wishes on his own behalf and on behalf of his organization for the success of the Conference. He highlighted about the cordial relationship between the Officers' Association and Award Staff Association PAN INDIA. He advised the members to be prepared for long drawn battle if they really wish to achieve something in the present scenario and asked the members to be prepared for the long drawn agitation against the Govt. of India on the issue of privatization of the Public Sector Banks.

Thereafter, Com.Ajay Jaggi, President, SBISA, Delhi Circle conveyed thanks to one and all and the Inaugural Session ended with a Vote of Thanks to the Chair and slogans of "Zindabad-Zindabad" by thousands of participants and the meeting was adjourned for Lunch.

At 4:00 P.M. after the Lunch the meeting was set to order by the Chief Secretary to conduct the business of the delegate session as per the Agenda circulated by him.

The Chief Secretary advised the house that we do not have at present any President, so we need to elect one to transact the business as per the Agenda and proposed the name of Comrade Sunil Chugh, the General Secretary, SBISA, Delhi Circle to preside over the Delegate session which was approved unanimously.

Thereafter, the Chief Secretary took up the undernoted agenda in seriatim:

i) To adopt Chief Secretary's Report on the working of the Union together with the Audited Statements of Accounts of the Union as approved by the Central Committee.

The Chief Secretary read out the report on the working of the Association together with the Audited Statements of Accounts of the Union as approved by the Central Committee, while participating on the discussions it was pointed out that under the Centennial Celebrations the Guwahati Circle has organized the Youth Convention as well the Disciplinary Proceedings classes which should be incorporated as part of the Centennial Celebration in the Chief Secretary's Report.

The house unanimously approved the Chief Secretary's Report with the abovementioned amendment and also unanimously approved the Audited Statements of Accounts of the Association for the years 2018, 2019 and 2020 with thunderous applause.

ii) To consider proposals for amendments to the Rules and Constitution of the Union as recommended by the Central Committee or as required under Rule-41.

Thereafter, the Chief Secretary took up the agenda of amendments to the Rules and Constitution of the Union as recommended by the Central Committee or as required under Rule-41 before the house. The house deliberated on the issue and all the amendments proposed by the Chief Secretary duly approved by the Central Committee were approved unanimously with great applause by the house.

iii) To elect the President, Vice Presidents, Chief Secretary, Dy. Chief Secretaries, General Treasurer, Asstt. General Treasurers of the Central Committee for the next term.

The Chief Secretary advised the house that we should be allowed to take up the agenda as the last agenda. The House unanimously approved the same.

iv) To consider notices(s) of Resolution(s) as recommended by the Central Committee.

After detailed discussions the house unanimously approved all the Resolutions as recommended by the Central Committee.

Thereafter, the Chief Secretary took up the Agenda No.iii) to elect the President, Vice Presidents, Chief Secretary, Dy. Chief Secretaries, General Treasurer, Asstt. General Treasurers of the Central Committee for the next term.



The house unanimously elected Com.Pradip Kumar Baishya as the Chief Election Officer and Com.Akhilesh Mohan as the Presiding Officer. Thereafter, they invited the names for the post of President of the Association, Com.Sanjay K. Singh the name of Com.Sunil Chugh for the post of President of the proposed Association and Com.Goutam Neogy seconded the same. Since there was no other nomination, so Com.Sunil Chugh was declared as PRESIDENT of the State Bank of India Staff Association(8 Circles) unopposed. Thereafter, the election officer invited the name for Sr.Vice-Presidents on the basis of one from each Circle. Since there was no nomination so it was decided to keep all the positions vacant. Then, the Chief Election Officer asked for the nomination for the post of Chief Secretary. Com.Azat Shatru proposed the name of Com.Sanjeev Kumar Bandlish which was seconded by Com.Raghunath Prasad Das. Since there was no other nomination, so, Com.Sanjeev Kumar Bandlish was declared Chief Secretary of State Bank of India Staff Association(8 Circles) unopposed. The Election Officer asked for the name for the post of Dy.Chief Secretary, one for each Circle. Since there was no nomination so, it was decided to keep all the positions of Dy.Chief Secretaries vacant. Then he asked nomination for the post of General Treasurer

which has to be from the Headquarters of the Association as per the Rules and Constitution of the Association. Com.Goutam Neogy proposed the name of Com.Raghubar Singh which was seconded by ComAbhoy Deo Sharma. Since there was no other nomination, Com.Raghubar Singh was declared elected as General Treasurer of State Bank of India Staff Association(8 Circles). Thereafter, the Chief Election Officer asked for the nominations for the posts of Two Asstt.General Treasurer from the H.Q. of the Association as per the Rules and Constitution of the Association and the 3rd Astt.General Treasurer will be from Chandigarh Circle wherefrom the Chief Secretary has been elected. Com.Goutam Neogy proposed the name of Com.Swastik Datta and Com.Partha Sarthi Das For the posts of Asstt.General Treasuers from the H.Q. and Abhoy Deo Sharma seconded the same. Regarding the 3rd position of Asstt.General Treasurer, the Chief Secretary did not proposed any name for the same. In the absence of any other nomination both the Asstt.General Treasurers proposed from the Headquarter were declared as elected and third position was kept vacant as there was no nomination for the same.

Thereafter, the comrades started shouting the slogans for the elected comrades and started garlanding them in a big way.

v) To consider any other matter not covered by the above of which at least 15 days notice has been given to the Chief Secretary by any Circle.

Lastly, this agenda to consider any other matter not covered by the above of which at least 15 days notice has been given to the Chief Secretary by any Circle was taken up and since there was no other agenda except the proposal for passing a resolution for excellent arrangement made by the comrades of SBISA-Delhi Circle to make the stay comfortable one and the excellent quality of food and hospitality, hotels etc., which was unanimously passed by the House and there being no other agenda to be discussed, so, the meeting ended with the Vote of Thanks to the Chair.""
